5. We'll go to the beach unless it rains. Unless it rains, we'll go to the beach.
6. Until they've left, try to stay focused. Try to stay focused until they've left.
7. Wherever you end up, let's stay in touch. Let's stay in touch wherever you end up.
8. We'll check in as soon as we arrive. As soon as we arrive, we'll check in.
9. You have to do it even if you hate it. Even if you hate it, you have to do it.
10. Once you finish this, you can go home. You can go home once you finish this.
